Shooting Stars Performing Arts is following all standard safety practices put forth by the State as they relate to COVID-19 in order to provide a safe place for our dancers, families, and employees.

We have increased overall cleaning and sanitization of our facilities and implemented the policies and procedures included in this "COVID-19 HANDBOOK". Shooting Stars Performing Arts reserves the right to alter our policies as new guidelines are established by state and/or local authorities..

No Spectators Allowed

Spectators, including parents, guardians, visitors, siblings, and guests for dancers K-12 are not permitted inside the facility. Preschool dancers may have 1 chaperone per family for drop off and pick up purposes only. This chaperone must wear a face mask inside and outside the facility, maintain 6 ft. social distancing, and will not be allowed inside the building for a cumulative time of more than 15 minutes and will not be permitted to wait inside the building during class. All non-dancers must wear a face mask and maintain 6 ft. social distancing during drop off and pick up. Non-dancers may not congregate in the parking lot.

Face Masks required inside & outside the facility

Face masks are required for all staff, students, and spectators inside and outside of the facility and during all dance activities. Masks must cover nose/mouth completely and must not be a face shield. Dancers will be allowed supervised "mask breaks" during times when we can ensure social distancing during class.

Medical exceptions will be reviewed on an individual basis.

Classes have limited capacity & no class overlaps

Class sizes are limited based on studio space. Each student will have their own 6 ft x 6 ft space for class and/or their own mat at all times. This designated area will also house student belongings (shoes, water bottles, etc.). We have built-in breaks between class changes to ensure time for cleaning/disinfecting as well as socially distant exit and entry. All students will remain together in one dance room for an entire class time.

Temperatures taken daily before entering facilities

Students' and assistants' temperatures will be taken with contactless thermometers upon entry. Anyone with a temperature 100.5 or above will not be permitted to enter the facility. Parents should wait in the parking lot for students to pass the temperature check and be admitted to class.

NO FOOD/DRINK

Food/drink are not permitted inside the facility other than student-provided water bottles which will remain in the student's designated space.



RESTROOM PROCEDURES

Individual restrooms will be regularly disinfected. Studios will be assigned to specific restrooms to prevent cross contamination between student populations.



HAND SANTIZER

Students will be provided with and required to use hand sanitizer upon entry of the facility.



EQUIPMENT USAGE

Ballet barres, equipment, and props will be used on a very limited basis. Any studio-provided equipment used will be individually assigned and will be cleaned, sanitized, and disinfected between each use.
